
Over 10,000 people die every year because of a drunk driver.

In 2015, 1.1 million drivers were arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs.



underage RUNK DRIVING

- 10% of teens in high school drink and drive.
- Drivers ages 16 to 20 are 17 times more likely to die in a crash when legally intoxicated than those who have not been drinking.
- Teens in high school drive after drinking approximately 2.4 million times a month.

AVOIDING drunk driving

- If going out for the evening, arrange transportation ahead of time.
- 2. Designate a sober driver when out with friends.
- Have ridesharing services installed on your phone or keep the contact info of a cab company.
- If planning a party where alcohol will be served, offer non-alcoholic alternatives.
- 5. Collect the keys of anyone who has consumed alcohol.
